## **OVERVIEW**

The Alamo Chapter of Credit Unions (ACCU) is dedicated to the educational and networking needs of credit union employees within the chapter area. The ACCU Scholarship Program is designed to help credit union employees develop and enhance their skills and expertise.

To foster participation in events, conferences and seminars that further credit union employees, the ACCU will offer full or partial scholarships to any and all credit union employees in order to attend the following:

- Credit union related conference or event
- Job skill related conference or event
- Leadership development conference or event

Funding for these scholarships will be provided through ACCU organization dues. Accordingly, participation in the scholarship program is open only to employees of credit unions that are dues-paying members of the Alamo Chapter of Credit Unions.

In addition to event or conference registration fees, scholarships may also cover related costs as part of the program package, such as transportation or hotel fees. Please note that personal expenses are not included in the ACCU Scholarship Program. Additionally, ACCU Scholarship funds cannot be used toward expenses for the spouse, significant others or children of the applicant.

Please be sure to answer the application completely.

Incomplete applications may not be considered for an ACCU Scholarship.

## SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify, applicants must be able to show:

- They are an employee of a Credit Union that is a dues-paying member of the ACCU
- Will be attending a job skill conference or event, a credit union related conference or event, and/or a leadership development conference or event
- Have the potential for sharing your learning with others in your credit union or chapter
- Have not received a prior ACCU scholarship within the previous 1 year.
